Carriage Return

Sometimes, your barcode may not be configured to press the **[ENTER]** key after scanning. If you scan your item and it doesn't automatically ring anything up OR if you scan it into notepad and you see the cursor blinking on the same line, you must scan the barcode below to program the scanner to do so.
